A WORD OF INTRODUCTION

As we begin our time together, I thought it might be helpful for me to say a few words of introduction.

So, Hi! I am Rev. Dale Suggs, and I am proud to be the Interim Senior Pastor of First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) of Orange. I also am proud to be the spouse of Shelly Suggs. We have been married 28 years and have 4 beautiful daughters . . . Amy (22), Julia (20), Molly (17) and Grace (15). Amy graduated from TCU in May and is now an Assistant Band Director at Bowie High School in Austin, Texas. Julia is currently a Junior at National University, but the biggest news in her life is that she and her long-time sweetheart, Anthony, are expecting a baby in January. (Yes, I am going to a grandfather!) Molly is a Senior in high school and hopes to go to the University of California at Berkeley or the University of Oregon next year. Grace is a Sophomore and has a passion for volleyball. My father and stepmother, Jim & Gail Suggs, have been members of FCCO for several years. It's an unusual and unplanned circumstance, but I count it as a great blessing. During my ministry with FCCO, Shelly, Molly and Grace, will continue to live, work and go to school in San Diego. My usual schedule will have me in Orange five days a week. I will travel to San Diego on Thursday afternoons and will return to Orange late on Saturdays.

Educationally, I am a graduate of Texas Christian University and Brite Divinity School in Fort Worth, Texas. I also studied at the Ecumenical Institute at Bossey, Switzerland, which a joint living-learning experience of the University of Geneva and the World Council of Churches. There I lived and studied with 60 students from 33 countries representing more faith backgrounds than I can name. It was a truly life-changing experience.

Professionally, I was as a youth minister in a Methodist Church in Fort Worth, Texas, while in seminary. I also participated in summer internships at churches in South Bend, Indiana, and Wichita Falls, Texas. Ordained in 1987, I served as Senior Minister at Central Christian Church in Lebanon, Indiana, and Torrey Pines Christian Church in La Jolla, California.

Many of you may know that I took a break from pastoral ministry beginning in 2005. And for the last four years, I have served as a Spiritual Counselor (Chaplain) for San Diego Hospice and the Institute for Palliative Medicine. This was an amazing experience. Day in and day out, I had the blessing of providing compassionate presence, reinforcing faith journeys wherever they may have traveled, and engaging issues of meaning, worth and ultimate concern. I do not have the words to express the faith I witnessed and the depth of what I learned.

For the last few years, however, I felt the pull to return to pastoral ministry. Over the last year, I engaged in a journey of spiritual discernment in order to come to a deeper understanding of God's call in my life. That journey led me to begin looking for opportunities to minister in a local congregation. I cannot imagine a better opportunity than to serve here at FCCO. I count myself extremely blessed.

During the next year, I look forward to sharing a journey of spiritual discernment with you as well. It is my hope that together we will come to a deeper understanding of God's call for FCCO. It is my hope that we will be able to affirm or to reaffirm the ministries that answer that call. And it is my hope that, because of this journey, FCCO will be better equipped to call and to welcome a new Senior Pastor to share in these vital and transformative ministries for years to come.

I want to give thanks to the search committee that brought me to FCCO. They represented the people and ministries of the church with conviction and true excitement. I want to give thanks to the staff who are providing valuable guidance and support. I want to thank the leadership of the church who are demonstrating passion for their respective ministries and the community with whom share these ministries. And I want to thank all the people of this congregation who together have welcomed me with open arms . . . or should I say, "Open Hearts, Open Minds, and Open Arms." I look forward to being your companion in proclaiming the Gospel, caring for those in need, fellowshiping with the whole people of God, and reaching out to the community God has called us to serve both in word and deed.
