Holy week is fast approaching, and our Wilderness 101 journey will culminate in the magnificent crescendo of the resurrection! Most of us will enter this week not unscathed. Some of life's lessons are hard...very hard. And even the gentle lessons leave scars.

We are all still in the school of life, and the classes are sometimes huge and sometimes very small. The whole world is in attendance. In reality we never graduate, we just keep on learning... hopefully.

One of my favorite quotes goes like this: *"If only I didn't know now,"* sang Bob Seeger, *"what I didn't know then."* Another is by Aldous Huxley: *"Experience is not what happens to you; it is what you do with what happens to you."* Life is not a test, but that doesn't mean we haven't been tested.

I know that during this Wilderness 101 journey I have at times felt lost... especially this past week with the death of my 47 year old niece. Lost hardly begins to express the grief of my family. Lost is of course many things, and it can happen in school or out of school, but it certainly, like most of life, is filled with contradictions. Learning comes with a cost. Sometimes it's very expensive. One of these learnings we all learn is that none of us can be found who have not felt lost.

Perhaps as we all think about those who have slipped between the cracks of the world this year we can be comforted in the community of this shared sad circle and see the threads that bind us to one another. I am so grateful for the community that is First Christian Church of Orange... It is where I feel found!
