## Keeping in Touch...

How do you know if you have a strong youth group? Here are some “thou shalt nots” and “thou shalts” which I believe to be keys to building strong spiritual youth (and kids).



Thou *shalt not* judge a youth group by Youth Sunday. Even though this Sunday is going to be amazing, Youth Sunday is a standard yearly event in most Disciple churches. A person can not judge a church by the fact it has a Youth Sunday. A church can judge the strength of its youth by how they are involved in leadership every Sunday and weekday during the year. Do they serve on committees, in leadership, and worship beyond one Sunday a year? Our youth do!

Thou *shalt not* judge a strong youth group based on the number of youth. Some of the most powerful and influential youth come from groups where barely “two or more” are gathered. Popular is not the same as faithful. What a group wants is those who think being faithful should be popular. We have youth who are really studying their faith and implementing it in their day to day lives.

Thou *shalt* know the names (not the parent’s names or the last name) of the youth. Do you know Courtney, David, Madison, Nick, Emily, Ashanti, Taylor, Melinda, Paul, and Kari? These are our active CYF youth. Do you know which ones play instruments, ice skate, and perform? We have a talented bunch of youth. Let their talents bless you.

Thou *shalt* be nice to those who work with the youth. Our church has an amazing group of adults that gather each week to have fun, learn, and organize all the busy events that happen. Strong youth groups have one adult for every five youth. Those who do not work with the youth support, pray, and encourage those who do. It is a team effort, even when a person is on the sidelines.

Thou *shalt* LOVE your youth. Strong youth groups are part of strong churches that love them... really, love them. Even if you do not know all their names, many of you give the youth opportunities to learn. You teach them what it means to be a Christian by example. You give them chances to go do mission work, go to camp, and even go have fun. You are leading our youth in the ways of following Christ.

Thank you for being a church that follows these “commandments.” There are many more aspects to what makes a strong youth group including good parents, great listening skills, and engaging in deep dialogue and this church does well in those areas too. It is not always perfect, smooth, or easy, but it is... Youth! It is youth with all its up and downs, chaos and questions, and drama and blessings.

I went home from work Sunday evening with a big smile on my face because I was blessed by our youth and kids, and those amazing adults who work with them. Thou shalt be smiling too!
