Keeping In Touch...



My first introduction to the “larger church” was when I was a freshman in high school, and our minister, Rev. Harry Nissen, took a group from Glendora First Christian Church into the Hollywood Bowl on a Sunday morning for the 1960 International Convention mass communion service. Evidently it was the conclusion to a gathering much like our current General Assemblies, although the Christian Churches at that time were considered only a “Brotherhood,” fairly loosely connected. Then in 1969 I attended the first real General Assembly in Seattle, and I’ve only missed one since. We’ve gotten more connected, organized, and concise.

While General Assemblies have varied in success, this past assembly in Nashville did not disappoint. I’ve always gone for the inspiration of the worship and the collegiality, but this time there was a succession of speakers who were insightful, inspiring, and convicting. From theologian Harvey Cox to local pastor’s sharing their stories in witness, I found myself encouraged about the church. In similar manner there were workshops and forums for discussion about immigration and war... tough issues for the church today. One of the most challenging speakers was Mel White at the GLAD dinner. He addressed our penchant for discernment, which we have been doing for 20 years with LGBT issues. “Isn’t it time we made a decision?” he asked. It’s true, discernment by definition leads to a decision, and not to decide is to decide.

Of course we no longer “debate” issues on the business floor. Much of the rancor is gone. But I must confess that much of the passion seems to be gone as well. As painful as many of those debates used to be, there was also a sense of movement. Now much of what we do is sent off to committees or congregations to study and discern. At sometime we have to decide.

There were 18 members from FCC Orange who attended. I am proud of our involvement in the General and Regional church, and if you have never been to a “large church” gathering, Regional or General, I would encourage you to attend. While the church does seem to plod along, there is nothing as uplifting as 5,000 gathered voices proclaiming faith together. If you have the means to watch some of this on line, I encourage you to do so. In the opening worship you will see our own Madison Oliver bringing the light through remarkable dance!
