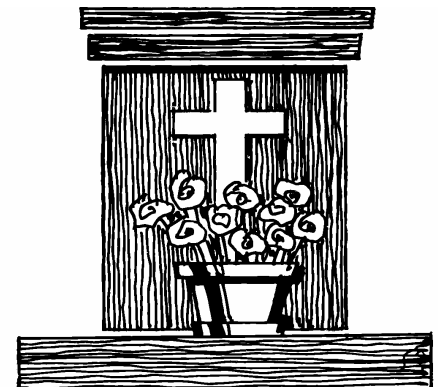

In a few short days I will move from being Senior Pastor of First Christian Church to being retired. When I came to be your pastor in 1992, I had no image of what this would be like. I am so grateful for being able to love and be loved, for lessons learned and gifts unearned, for the blessings of paths traveled together, and for hearts freely shared. There is so much that I take with me... tender and vulnerable moments linked to celebrations of life... and death...and life again. I take with me open hearts, open minds, open arms... into a new world.

Over the past 19 years, I have joined with you in more than 1,300 worship services, 121 baptisms, 56 infant dedications, 128 memorial services, and 28 weddings. I don't even want to count the number of committee meetings!

I am thankful for Stephen Ministry, strategic planning, Open and Affirming ministry, capital campaigns, Habitat builds, summer sermons, sacramental moments, and so much more. We have worked, laughed, cried, struggled and celebrated together! There is always more! I know that there is much that I leave behind. And much that I take with me. It is all good!

It is important for me to say, and for you to know, that I will honor the covenant that Disciple clergy make when they are ordained. I will take my leave as your pastor and without exception will pass the baton to the interim leadership and the next Senior Pastor of First Christian Church. I am remaining in the city of Orange, but I will not officiate at any weddings, memorial services, baptisms or other services at FCCO. I will find a new church, and probably sit in the back pew for a while. I will be one of your most enthusiastic supporters — but from a distance.

I will hold all of you in my thoughts and prayers. And I know that you are in good hands. They are your hands and God's hands, and you have strong lay and pastoral gifts. FCCO is a creative, faithful, blessed community that is welcoming of all people. Trust in that! Trust in God! Trust in the words of the prophet Micah: *What the Lord requires of us is that we do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with our God.* Trust in the magnificent joy of the Gospel.

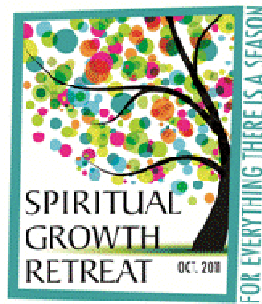

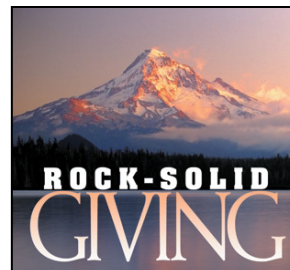
