## Reverend J. Dale Suggs

The Leadership Board met after Worship last Sunday, listened to the report from the Interim Committee and unanimously voted to call Rev. Suggs as our full time, Senior Interim Minister. He will begin November 27.



Dale was raised in a strong Disciples of Christ family, "with a deep respect for the church and a high commitment to its ministry." His education includes graduation from Texas Christian University and Brite Divinity School. He has other specialized training in leadership development, ecumenical studies, spiritual development, Stephen Ministry. Dale has served two large congregations with multiple staff. He brings gifts of strong preaching, pastoral attention to his people, planning and administrative skills, leading the church in processes of discernment. Currently, he is serving as Spiritual Counselor for San Diego Hospice and the Institute of Palliative Medicine.

Dale and his wife Shelly (see photo) have been married for 28 years and have four daughters. His interest include music, art history, gardening, and TCU football.

Please pray for our new Interim Minister and our serving together during this next period of our life together at First Christian Church of Orange.

Even though there are pumpkins all around, I have been thinking a lot about spring cleaning. In a healthy church, like ours, things are always changing, updating, and progressing forward. We are always in a "time of transition." What makes this time different is the same difference found in just picking up and dusting before company, and really digging in and going through the closets, garage, and even looking in the scary place behind your refrigerator. This church is in a time of "spring cleaning."



To really get everything clean and back into order, it first must become messy. It is time to pull out the carpet cleaner, the gloves, and start making a mess. All the clothes have to come out of the closet, the food has to come out of the cabinet, and the heavy duty carpet cleaner needs to be pulled from the garage.

Once everything is out of where it was being stored, it must be sorted. There are hats that need to be put back in the other closet and items that need to be relabeled. Items may be too old or just not necessary. Things must be thrown or given away. Shopping needs to be done and money spent to buy replacement items or new necessary things.

It is exhausting and hard work to spring clean. There are moments when your house looks like it has been turned upside down. You may find yourself wanting to go back and wishing you had never started this process; you wonder if in the end it will be worth it?

Yes! It will be worth it. When you can finally find the can of soup you were looking for all day and the socks that had fallen behind the washing machine; when there is not a funny smell coming from somewhere and everything smells clean; when you wear that new pair of shoes that fit just right, and they still have room to fit in the closet; and, when you can find your favorite hat, you will be glad that you cleaned.

In this church, we do not have to clean alone. As we take time to figure out who is in charge of what and where it needs to go, we are all together. As we make a mess and deal with the cobwebs hiding in the corners, we are all together. There will be moments of frustration, moments of exhaustion, and moments of exasperation, but we are all together. It's messy!

At the end, however, it will be worth it. We will know that together we cleaned and sorted through each part of our church life and that what we show to our guests goes much deeper than just a quick dusting. Instead they will find a place that can be a home, food that can help nourish them, and spaces where their stuff can be placed. Our guests can become part of our family and not just visitors, because we took time to make room for them, for us, and for God.

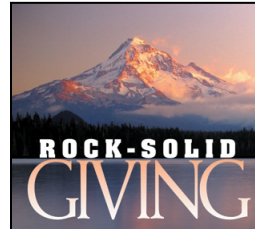
## DISCIPLES WOMEN AND DISCIPLES MEN

## Rock of Ages

A tiny British territory on the coast of southern Spain has loomed large in history for hundreds of years. In ancient times it marked the limit to the known world. To pass beyond it was to sail to certain destruction over a bottomless waterfall at the edge of the world.

This spectacular two-and-a-half-square-mile rock monolith has been the subject of repeated conquest and sieges, sparkling legends and stories dating back to Bible times. Strategically positioned overlooking the coast of Africa, it keeps watch over the intersection of two continents and the only entrance to the Mediterranean Sea from the Atlantic Ocean. Some call it the rock of ages; we know it as The Rock of Gibraltar.

Despite long sieges, on many occasions, over the centuries, Gibraltar has proved impervious to attack. To this day, its famous invincibility produces similes such as “strength of Gibraltar” and “solid as the Rock of Gibraltar” to describe a person or situation that cannot be overcome and does not fail.

Yes, if ever there was a rock-solid foundation on this earth, it is Gibraltar.

Yet as Christians, we have a Foundation that is even stronger, more solid, and truly conquered by no enemy.
