THOUGHTS FROM DALE . . .

A few weeks ago, I shared from the Lord's Table a short list of things that *"I know without a doubt."* After worship, someone suggested that making a statement like that in a Disciple's church was pretty bold. I had to admit her that I hadn't considered that before I offered my list that morning. Since then I have. And maybe she was right.

I am a life-time member of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). And, in those 50 years, I have experienced a wide range of theological sensibilities from our Disciple sisters and brothers.

- Some draw strength and comfort from the God who is active in our lives; and, others draw strength from the community of the church that continues Jesus' ministry.
- Some believe that prayer invites God to intervene in the happenings of our world; and, others believe that prayer focuses the intention of the church upon the needs of those for whom we pray.
- Some witness to the power and presence of God the Parent, Son, and Holy Spirit, up close and personal; and, others witness to the power and the presence of the congregation of Christ's followers drawing along side them.
- Some declare Jesus as Lord because they believe He was both Human and Divine; and, others declare Jesus as Lord because they believe in His compelling message and the followers who continue to proclaim and enact His teachings in our world.
- And then there are some like me who find these distinctions not to be contradictory but instead to be complementary.

Yes, there are a wide range of beliefs in our denomination and in our congregations. Part of our strength is that all perspectives are welcomed here, discussed here and challenged here. (That last one is important.) And hopefully, by God's grace, experiencing our diversity can empower our mutual transformation and enliven our common commitment to go out into the world to continue Jesus' ministry of hope and healing *"to the least of these."* Because no matter how lively the debate, if we aren't inspired to change who we are and to make a difference in the lives of those in need, then even our best words have little to do with being a disciple of Jesus.

So, I guess I'd like for my words a few Sundays ago to be an expression of faith rather than a declaration of truth. And whether offered that Sunday or today or any other day, I'd like for my expressions of faith to be an invitation to dialogue with your expressions of faith in the hope that together we will be better equipped and more deeply devoted to our ministry in Jesus' name.

To this end, I share again my Invitation to Commune with Christ and with you from a few weeks ago.

I believe . . .

- That grace is true
- That faith is powerful
- That love is life-changing
- That hope is worth hanging onto
- That healing . . . deep-down from the inside out healing . . . is real
- And the only place where all of this is available week in and week out is this community we call the church.
